**We are all called to share the
gospel. It's not just for
evangelists, but for every
believer. We are the workers!**

Keys to sharing your faith:

- 1. Be ready to share your testimony (practice sharing in under 2 minutes)**
- 2. Ask good questions**
- 3. Memorize some key passages of scripture (start with the Roman Road)**
- 4. Ask the Holy Spirit for a prophetic word for someone and share it with them.**

Ask Questions:

- 1. Do you believe in and have a relationship with Jesus Christ?**
- 2. What does it take for someone to go to heaven?**
- 3. Do you think there's a purpose to life, and if so, what do you think it is?**
- 4. If God were real and wanted a relationship with you, would you want to know Him?**
- 5. Where does hope come from for you?**

Memorize the Roman Road:

- Romans 3:23 “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...”
- Romans 5:8 “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”
- Romans 6:23 “For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”
- Romans 8:1 “Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”

Memorize the Roman Road:

- Romans 10:9 “If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”
- Romans 10:10 “For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.”
- Romans 10:13 “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

Another great way to start a conversation with someone about Jesus is to ask them how you can pray for them?
